This gives a fantastic reference point to calibrate our hygrometer. There is an easy way to determine if your hygrometer is accurate. You want a damp pile of salt in the bottle cap. After 8 hours in the damp salt environment, the actual humidity inside the bag will be 75%. Compare it to your hygrometer, your hygrometer should also read 75%. If not, you will then know exactly how far off your hygrometer is. If the hygrometer has a control to adjust it either the needle or the display, you can set the hygrometer to 75% immediately after the test. A standalone digital hygrometer cannot usually be installed to the exterior of a humidor, but can be placed on the floor of the humidor or mounted up on the interior of the lid. With a salt test, you are manually creating an environment of 75% humidity which you can then introduce the hygrometer into to test its accuracy. Created by the Boveda company, the onestep calibration kit consists of a zipperequipped bag and an 8gram, 75% Boveda pouch. Simply slip your hygrometer in the bag, zip it up, and leave it in for 24 hours. At 100% accuracy, your hygrometer will be reading 75%. If not, you can remove it from the bag and adjust the calibration. According to Boveda Inc, each calibration kit is good for approximately one year. Place the cap inside the bag with the hygrometer. Seal the bag and wait 4 hours. Through the bag, push and hold the green button until the hygrometer resets itself to 75. Once it has reset, remove from the zip lock bag. Your hygrometer is now perfectly calibrated. However, before each calibration, it will be necessary to remove and reinsert the batter which allows the unit to reset. This unit will read humidity in the range of 30% to 90%. Should the relative humidity be outside this range, the unit will show to dashes. This simply means the humidity is outside the readable range. The unit is functioning normally. For each one, I completed the initial adjustment using Bovedas 1Step Calibration Kit. They now all show within 2% the same humidity readings. So, Im convinced this product works as advertised, and am upgrading my rating to five stars. I restore vintage guitars.

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After trying nearly every other brand of digital hygrometer to track my shops humidity, including AccuRight which really should be called AccuWRONG, I now trust only HygroSets.Front bracket came off, but. Front bracket came off, but is not effecting the unit.To me, this gives me an uneasy feel. I wanted a precalibrated, ready to use device. Not something I had to calibrate. Supposedly it comes with a special bag that allows for calibration. I didnt get the bag. No way to calibrate it

except with another hygrometer. It reads 39% RH when it should be over 50%. It does not have enough adjustment to set it high enough. I have the dial turned as high as it will go and it is still off by more than 10% RH. Total junk. Dont buy. Save your money. I have not use for this item.Bottom line the product does not work at all!The bad reviews are not based on any genuine or accurate technical testing. However my review is based on fairly good technical testing as well as experience. I had been searching for an accurate, affordable and reliable hygrometer for use with my vintage and collectible guitars. Because of the value of my collection, I wanted a Hygrometer that was consistently accurate. I also needs an easy way to calibrate the Hygrometer to my Reference Standard. After going through many, many, many Hygrometers, I found this one to be the best. This company also makes a round version of this that is the equal to this in accuracy and features. This review is for both models since I own both. All of these inexpensive meters are off out of the box from the factory. The Quality Importer Hygroset Meters reviewed here were always the closest. Calibrations is very easy to do with the knob on the Hygroset Meters. One click is about 2% which works out well. Once calibrated, I compare the inexpensive Hygrometers several times daily to the Calibrated Reference Reference Room Humidity Meter. I do this for at least Ten 10 days.

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To calibrate the inexpensive meters, I keep adjusting thm until they are stable and match my Calibrated Laboratory Reference Room Humidity Meter for at least Seven 7 Days in a row without adjustment. Once they do, I consider them calibrated. I then do a quick spot check mostly to make sue they are still holding the calibration. I am going on 9 months now with any need to recalibrate. All of my Hygrosets maintain the exact same reading as my Calibrated Laboratory Reference Room Humidity Meter. I also get my Calibrated Laboratory Reference Room Humidity Meter recalibrated to NIST Standards annually. These Hygrosets are superb and are dead on accurate. I just them to keep my entire guitar collection safe and stable. I HIGHLY Recommend the Quality Importers Hygroset Meters. They are superior and easier to use and calibrate than any others I have tried including more expensive versions. This unit is economical and adjustable. The unit will need to be calibrated when you first get it but once calibrated it will perform well. I use mine in my ukulele case and in my home to help maintain proper humidity levels. Although humidity gauges are supposedly preset at the factory, it's not unusual to find the calibration off once you get the unit home and placed in your humidor. If you want to see how accurate your hygrometer is, there is a simple, easytodo method you can use with items found right in your kitchen. Place a teaspoon of salt in the bottle cap and add a few drops of tap or distilled water to moisten it.

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Don't overdo it. You don't want to dissolve the salt. Add only enough water to dampen the salt. When water is added to common table salt, it will maintain an exact 75% humidity in a perfectly sealed environment. Carefully place the salt and your hygrometer into the airtight container. Try not to get any moistened salt on the gauge. Check the unit to assure its current reading is somewhere in the 40% to 80% range. Seal the container tightly but don't try to remove any remaining air trapped inside. Now, wait for at least several hours until the environment has stabilized this could take up to 6 hrs.. Do not open the container. Read the gauge's humidity % level. It should be exactly 75%. If it is not, note the deviation as being the amount your hygrometer is out of calibration. If for example, it reads 65%, the gauge is 10% low. If it reads 80%, the gauge is 5% high. Assuming your hygrometer has a calibrating screw on the back most better ones do take a very small flathead screwdriver and

turn it slowly while watching the dial on the front. If your gauge was low by 10%, turn the screwdriver so the dial is set 10 percentage points higher than it was previously. Conversely, if your gauge was high by 5%, turn the screw in the opposite direction to set the dial 5 percentage points lower. Your hygrometer should now be properly calibrated, which will help you maintain a healthier overall environment for your cigars. If the gauge does not appear to be moving, try blowing warm, moist air into the back of it. It's important to recalibrate your analog hygrometer every 6 months or so to make sure it's reading properly. The one that came with the hygrometer is off on its RH reading by 5% so it is currently reading a 61 so it is actually 66% which is beautiful for me as I know the reading. Now the Brigham wont stay she cuts out and the display fades away to a blank screen. I figured it was the battery so I replaced and it turns on for a bit and gives me the same crap. Now the question I have is should I stick with another Brigham or should I go with the round Xikar they have there. To further the question is the Xikar any good and is it reliable. Also is there any other makes I should try going for. Let me know. I know RH is rock solid but I still dont like not having one in there for safety and reassurance. Thanks all, JM Id return it just to avoid the frustration Thats why I was curious about the Xikar. Brigham has left a bad taste in my mouth now. The first four that I bought were Xikars. 2

of them work great and the other 2 had issues when I went to calibrate them. Basically when I pushed the calibration button they would reset to 75% as they should and then go to 73% on the next refresh cycle. I used a ziplock bag during the calibration process and pushed the calibrate button through the bag. In other words the RH in the bag should have stayed the same because I did not open it but the hygrometers still lost 2%. 2 of them did this and the other 2 stayed at 75%.

At this point I lost confidence that I was going to get an accurate reading so the next time I needed a hygrometer I bought a couple of Hygroset IIs. These were a bit harder to calibrate because you have to turn the little nob to adjust the reading and it was not really possible to do through the plastic bag however I am much happier with them because I trust the reading.
